COVID-19 RESPONSE PLAN

This is a summary of the key measures taken as part of the school's reopening plan.

The aim of these measures is to allow students, staff and all members of the school community to work and learn in a safe environment.

FEELING UNWELL

If a student reports that they are feeling unwell, they must stay at home.

If a student reports feeling unwell at school, they will be isolated until collected by a parent/guardian.

Symptoms of COVID-19

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or breathing difficulties
- Loss of smell or taste

ARRIVING TO SCHOOL

School begins at 8:50am. Students must wash or sanitize their hands before entering the building. All students must wear a face covering/mask on entry to the school.

THE SCHOOL DAY

Breaks are taken on rotation to limit the number of students in the canteen at any time. JC/TY/LCA1&2 are based in home rooms for most of their timetable.

IN CLASS

Students sit in an assigned seat. No sharing of materials. Books and materials stored in classrooms as there is no access to student lockers. Students must sanitize their area on a regular basis and when they must change room.

ON THE CORRIDORS

Students must follow the one-way system and adhere to physical distancing measures put in place.

UNIFORM

Students wear their normal uniform to school. Students wear the school PE uniform to school on days when they are timetabled for PE. Changing facilities will not be available.

FACE COVERINGS /MASK / SHIELD

All students must wear a mask or face shield in the school building at all times.

CANTEEN

Breakfast and lunch will be available from the canteen at staggered times. Students must follow the physical distancing Queue System in place and dispose of waste as directed.

CONTACT WITH YEARHEADS/MANAGEMENT TEAM

All contact with Yearheads/School Management will be via phone, email or video call (when appropriate). No meetings or appointments are being facilitated at this time.

LEAVING SCHOOL EARLY

If leaving school early, a student must be signed out by a parent/guardian at Reception. No student is permitted to leave the school grounds unless collected by a parent/guardian.
