What is this day about?

In Louth and Meath, a number of disability service providers facilitate rehabilitative training and day services for adults with disabilities which are funded by the HSE.

Individuals with the following disabilities may be supported:

Intellectual Disability with or without additional Physical or Sensory Disabilities,

Mental Health Difficulties and/or Autism Spectrum Disorder.

Rehabilitative training programmes are training courses to develop life skills, social skills and basic work skills for individuals with a disability. The courses typically last from two to three years. These courses can be a stepping stone to mainstream education and training options.

Adult day services are programmes which assist people to make choices, plans and be an active, independent member of the community. Service Providers deliver varying degrees of support to people with a very diverse set of needs, wishes and aspirations.

On **Tuesday 24th October 2023**, a number of disability service providers will be in **CityNorth Hotel** to meet individuals and their families who are interested in accessing the above programmes and provide information on their specific services. Representatives from the HSE Day Opportunities Team will also be present to inform you of the process to access these services.
